# STORIES OF IMPACT

## WRENS CAMPUS

For years, Stevens Creek Church carried a quiet prayer that one day we might become a five-campus church. While we remained open to that possibility, we were not actively pursuing expansion. In June 2025, the Lord opened a door in an unexpected way when leaders from a church in Wrens, Georgia, reached out after the passing of their lead pastor. With no plan for continuation, they prayerfully sought a ministry to carry forward their legacy and felt led to entrust their facilities to Stevens Creek so that a campus could serve their community.

After touring the downtown Wrens property and seeking God during August's 21 Days of Prayer, vision and clarity began to emerge. At the conclusion of that season, Pastor Marty formally received the remarkable gift of the property, along with financial support from the previous ministry to help prepare the space. With a few key updates including production equipment, streaming capabilities and the creation of a Creek Kids environment, the campus was positioned for ministry. As we look toward 2026, we do so with gratitude for the faithfulness of those who served before us and expectancy for the life change still to come through Stevens Creek Wrens.



## NORTH AUGUSTA CAMPUS

Jacob and Rachael Staub didn't come to Stevens Creek looking for a new church, they came because someone simply invited them. It wasn't a big moment, but God was already at work. For Rachael, 2024 felt like everything was falling apart; unexpected loss, anxiety, and days where she was barely holding on. She came without clarity, just a simple prayer: "God, I don't know what to do, but I'm trusting You." That prayer became a turning point. They joined a group, started serving, and stepped into community, and slowly God began restoring what felt broken. Over time, they both surrendered their lives to Christ and were baptized. Today, they serve faithfully at the North Augusta campus and the Dream Center, and their story all started with one step and one honest prayer.





## DREAM CENTER

60 Creekers have stepped up as Dream Builders, faithful partners who give \$30 or more each month to fuel the mission of our ministry. Their generosity makes a tangible difference, helping us feed hungry families, care for the sick and hurting, clothe those in need, empower people through education, and create opportunities for personal growth. Dream Builders aren't just supporters, they are essential to everything we do, turning compassion into action and vision into reality.



## GROVETOWN CAMPUS

When the Flack family began the process of getting their building repainted, a local painter offered to do additional work at her chiropractor's office. Instead of simply benefiting from the extra service, she chose to pay that generosity forward by investing back into the Grovetown campus. What started as a simple business exchange turned into a blessing for our church family and a beautiful reminder that kindness multiplies when we pass it on.



That same spirit of generosity showed up again through the Cantrell family, who donated a brand-new playground for the campus. What an incredible gift for our children and future generations, and it didn't stop there! Several men from our church stepped up to install and build it themselves. Because of their time, strength, and willingness to serve, what was once just a donation became a place where laughter, connection, and memories are now being made.

## SOUTH AUGUSTA CAMPUS

Brittney Partridge's life felt out of control. She didn't have a plan or answers, just the realization that she couldn't keep living the way she was. One night in a hospital room with her daughter, everything caught up to her, and she called her aunt, who simply invited her to church. On August 24, Brittney walked into Stevens Creek and knew she was home, and that day she stopped resisting God and simply said yes. Since then, she's been baptized, is faithfully attending with her kids, and her life has been transformed with peace and calm where chaos once lived all because she took one step.

## AUGUSTA CAMPUS

Kimberly found God in the spring of this year after years of searching for fulfillment in tarot cards, crystals, and destructive patterns that left her battling depression, severe anxiety, insomnia, and a deep sense of emptiness. After feeling prompted to throw away everything tied to her old life, she began experiencing intense spiritual attacks through nightmares and sleep paralysis until one terrifying night when, in the middle of overwhelming fear, she began praying in an unfamiliar language, crying out directly to God. In that moment, she was awakened and completely freed, and from that night forward the torment stopped. What once felt like darkness holding a tight grip on her life was replaced by peace, freedom, and a renewed sense of purpose. Today, Kimberly's anxiety has nearly vanished, she is surrounded by supportive, Christ-centered friendships through young adult bible study, and she wakes each day feeling confident, loved, and grateful to be alive. She was transformed by the faithful love of a God who heard her cries and answered.

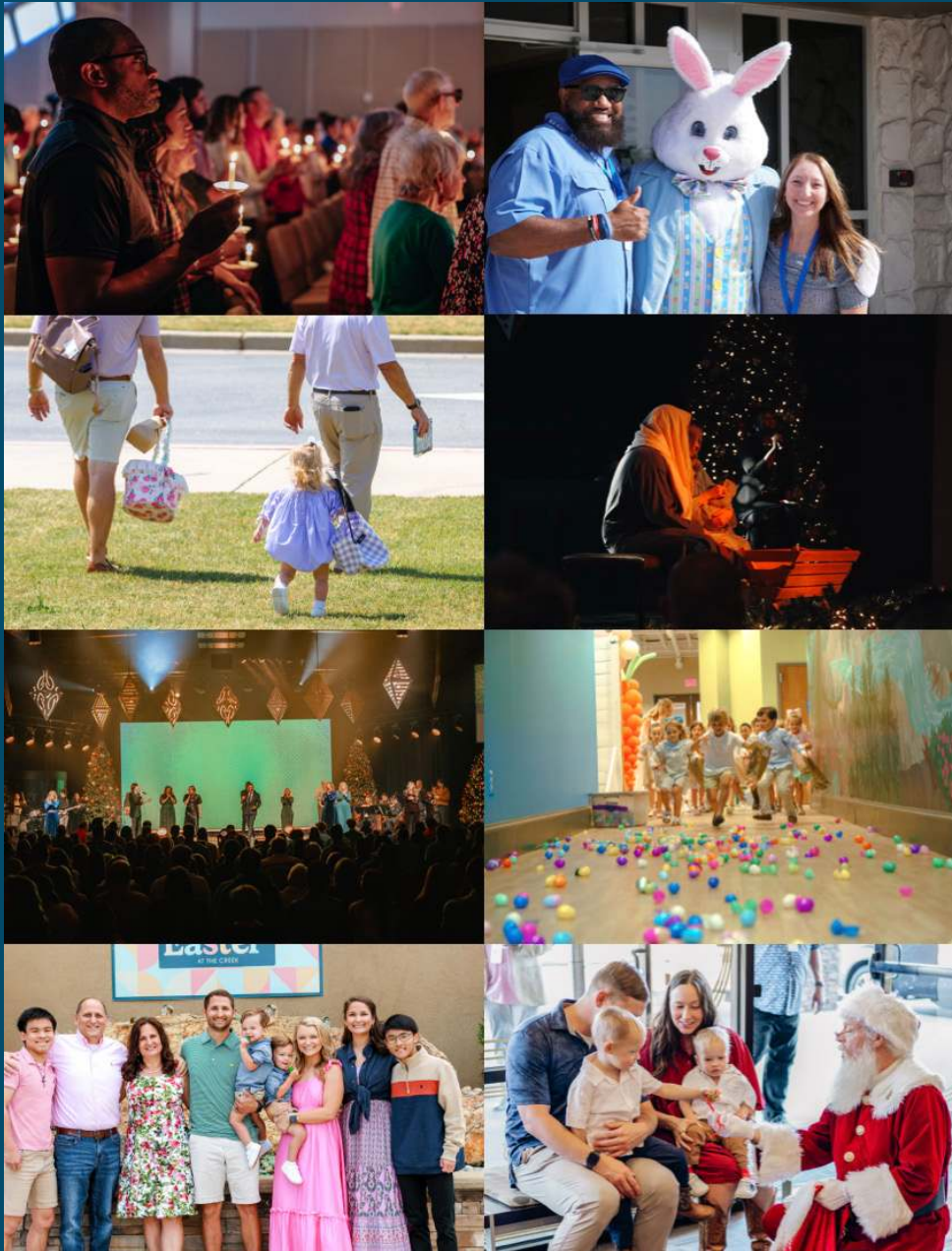

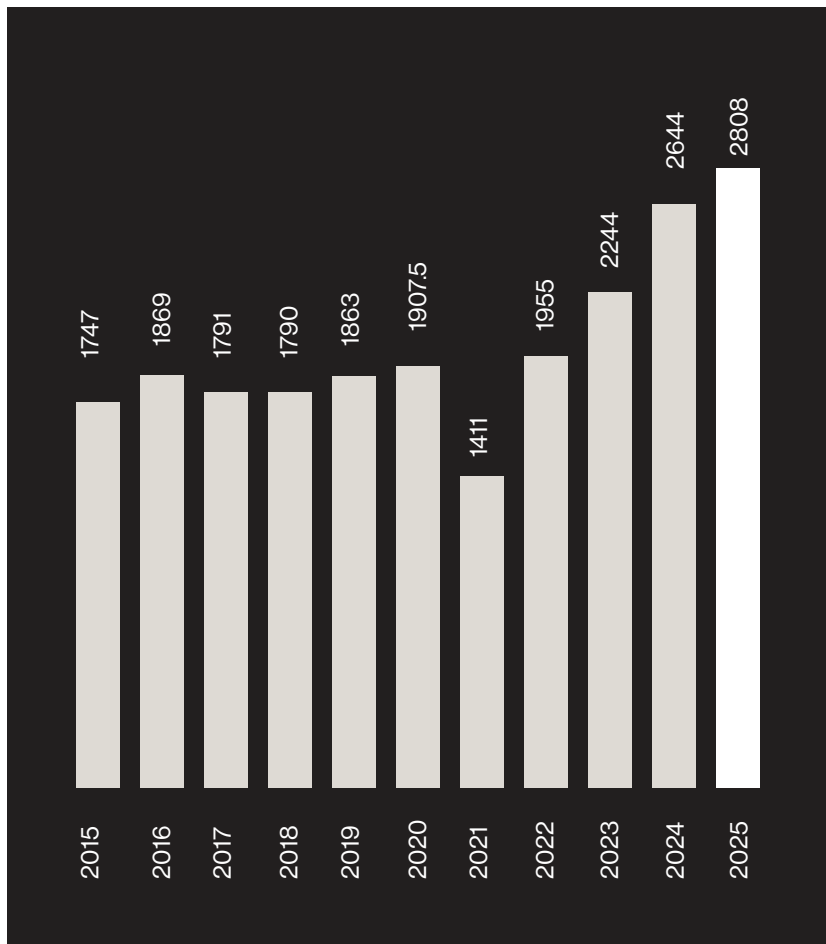

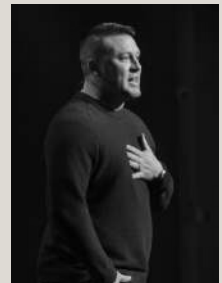
